

CIANJUR EARTHQUAKE 2022



In 2022, a 5.6-magnitude earthquake near the town of Cianjur in West Java, Indonesia, resulted in the displacement of at least 73,000 individuals. The devastating event also led to a tragic death toll exceeding 300 people, with approximately one-third being children who were trapped in collapsed homes or schools.

To provide support and assistance to the affected communities, Handara's CSR Program, in collaboration with our dedicated volunteers, extended help to several villages in the area. This included Desa Nagrak, Desa Cibereum, Desa Padaluyu, and Desa Cipetir. Our efforts focused on providing essential supplies such as "sembako" (daily necessities), food, water, medicines for babies, children, and adults, baby supplies, prayer sets, clothing, and small furniture items. Our intention was to alleviate the immediate needs of the impacted residents and offer them some comfort during this difficult period.
