COVID – 19



During the ongoing pandemic, we have been actively supporting local communities in their fight **against COVID-19**. The global outbreak of COVID-19 has presented an unprecedented challenge, affecting communities and economies worldwide. In response, governments, organizations from various industries and sectors, and individuals are joining forces to combat this global crisis.

As part of the Handara Giveback Program, we have visited Sanglah Hospital to provide assistance to the medical team working in isolation rooms, caring for COVID-19 patients. Our donations are intended to be of utmost use and support to the medical personnel during this critical period. It is crucial for healthcare professionals, such as doctors and nurses, to have access to Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Unfortunately, some referral hospitals in Indonesia have reported a shortage of protective gear for medical personnel who handle suspected COVID-19 cases. To address this issue, we have donated face shields to hospitals throughout Indonesia, with a particular focus on Bali. It is essential to protect the doctors and nurses as they face a significantly high risk of contracting the disease. We have provided assistance to several referral hospitals in Bali that are actively working to treat COVID-19 patients. These hospitals include Universitas Udayana Hospital, RSUD Tabanan, RSUD Buleleng, Sanglah Hospital, and Bali Mandara Hospital.

Amidst the COVID-19 pandemic, where 105,000 jobs have been lost and numerous NGOs have reported a significant portion of the population on the island of Bali facing food insecurity, the Handara Give Back Team has stepped up to alleviate their burden. We have collaborated with other charitable organizations on the island to distribute daily necessities ("*sembako*") and food to those in need in Bali. Our aim is to support the affected individuals and help alleviate the impact of the pandemic on their lives.
