

PALU & **DONGGALA 2018**











In September 2018, a powerful and shallow earthquake struck the northern coast of Sulawesi Island, causing widespread devastation. The cities of Palu and Donggala in Indonesia suffered immense destruction as a series of tsunami waves ravaged the coastline. The calamity resulted in the flattening of numerous homes, while inland areas experienced destructive mudflows and soil displacement. Tragically, the disaster claimed the lives of over 1,700 individuals, with more than 2,000 injured and many thousands still missing.

In collaboration with SSMS Medic, HCSR (Humanitarian Corporate Social Responsibility) played a crucial role in providing support to the affected regions. Through HCSR's coordinated efforts, donations were channeled to the stricken areas. SSMS Medic mobilized a team of multi-specialist medical doctors and paramedics who offered a range of services, including medical diagnostics, procedures, and the provision of essential medications. With their dedicated efforts, the SSMS team treated over 650 patients and visited numerous shelters, ensuring that medical care reached those in need.
